## 2018 – 2019 Tuition and Fees

---

St. John Paul works with every family to make Catholic education possible for all, through Florida tax credit scholarships and other forms of assistance. The financial aid section below contains information which may help to reduce your out of pocket expenses. **We encourage all families to complete our new easy to use tuition assistance application.** Please know that we will continue in our commitment to work with every family that desires a Catholic education for their children.

### Tuition

- Kindergarten – 5<sup>th</sup> grade \$6,645
- 6<sup>th</sup> grade – 8<sup>th</sup> grade \$6,945
- 4 year old - VPK full day \$3,585
- 4 year old – VPK (half day) \$0 (paid by VPK \$2,317)
- 3 year old – EC3 \$6,020
- 3 year old – EC3 half day \$3,010
  
- Registration Fee \$250

### Scholarships and Tuition Assistance Available through:

- **Catholic Schools Tuition Aid Grant (CSTAG)** - Income based Diocesan grant to help families with tuition costs. Applications available through FACTS. Available for those who do not qualify for Step-Up
- **Mary C. Forbes** - Need based scholarship reserved for students within the Diocese of St. Petersburg who are active practitioners of the Roman Catholic faith. Application available through school office
- **Step Up for Students** - An income-based scholarship for families needing financial assistance – covers tuition and fees [www.stepupforstudents.org](http://www.stepupforstudents.org)
- **Gardiner Scholarship** - A program through Step Up, for students with Special Needs – can cover tuition/fees/additional support as needed for success. [www.stepupforstudents.org](http://www.stepupforstudents.org)
