Saint John Paul II Catholic School works with every family to make Catholic education possible for all through Florida tax credit scholarships and other forms of assistance. The financial aid section below contains information which may help to reduce your out-of-pocket expenses. Please know we will continue our commitment to work with every family desiring a Catholic education for their children.

Tuition

- Kindergarten – 8th grade \$8,310
- 4 year old - VPK full day \$3,969
(Subject to change due to changes in the program by the Florida Department of Education)
- 4 year old - VPK half day \$0 (With VPK Voucher)
- 3 year old - EC3 full day \$6,760
- 3 year old - EC3 half day \$3,380
- Registration Fee (All Students) \$270
- Security Fee (All Students) \$200
- Security Fee (EC3 ½ Day) \$100
- Security Fee (EC3 Full Day) \$200
- Security Fee (VPK Full Day) \$100
- No Fees for ½ day VPK \$0
- Aftercare \$6.00/Hr. + \$1 per minute after 5:30pm

Scholarships and Tuition Assistance Available:

- Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA)(Formerly known as Gardiner) - A program offered through Step Up For Students with special needs - <https://www.stepupforstudents.org/for-parents/special-needs/how-the-scholarship-works/> and <https://www.aascholarships.org/parents/florida/>
- Catholic Schools Tuition Grant (CSTAG) - Income based Diocesan grant to help families with tuition costs. Applications are available through FACTs Grant & Aid. Available for those who do not qualify for FES, Step Up, or AAA and must be a member of a Catholic Parish.
- School Based Tuition Assistance - Supplemental assistance available through the school. Applications are available through the school office.

Please note that families are allowed to apply for both Step Up and AAA Scholarships, however you are only able to utilize one of the scholarships. The same policy applies to the FES-UA Scholarships. The actual cost to operate the school exceeds tuition costs. Subsidies from the Diocese of St. Petersburg, donations and fundraisers make up the difference between tuition and the actual cost it takes to educate a student at Saint John Paul II Catholic School.
